The Yellow Door Choir continues its 30th anniversary celebrations with a lively spring concert in support of the Mosaik Family Resource Center, a non-profit organization (NPO) in the west end dedicated to the support and enrichment of young families.

The concert plays on timeless themes – family, tradition, love, and renewal – and features a mosaic of songs reflecting our heritage as Canadians. Audiences will have trouble staying in their seats when fiddler extraordinaire Kate Bevan-Baker joins in the fun. She'll be driving the beat for several toe-tapping numbers. It could almost be a down-home kitchen party when Kate fiddles along during Celtic-inspired numbers such as Riverdance and Song for the Mira. Other numbers include folk tunes both traditional (J'entends le Moulin and Scarborough Fair) and from further afield (Cuando tú no estás, a choral tango from South America). Also on the bill are Broadway favourites Tradition, from Fiddler on the Roof, and Singing in the Rain.

Former members, friends, and more than one generation of family are joining the celebrations by participating in small ensembles, writing new music, and helping in the huge behind-the-scenes task of producing a concert. Thus the Yellow Door Choir brings together a varied group of people of diverse musical and cultural backgrounds, joining in community to create the joyful tapestry of sound that is choral music.
